SCHOLARHIP INCENTIVES:

- •HAVE TAKEN THE SAT OR ACT
- PASS AN ARMY PHYSICAL FITNESS ASSESSMENT
- •MEET PHYSICAL WEIGHT AND HEIGHT REQUIREMENTS
- •AGREE TO ACCEPT A COMMISSION AND SERVE IN THE ARMY ON ACTIVE DUTY OR IN ARMY RESERVE OR ARMY NATIONAL GUARD UPON GRADUATION

INCREASING YOUR CHANCES TO WIN

PT Test: Max points are 50/50/6:30 for males. Females 40/50/7:18 (push-ups/curl-ups/run)

Overall Board Score (Academics, Fitness, Leadership, PMS Interview, Essays, and CBEF questionnaire) should be 1200 out of a possible 1400.
